

Ralph and Zelma (Noel) Dines wrote in March, 1967 that the 1909 picture is of a summer term. "Winter and Summer terms were the usual thing way back then - I know that had changed by the time we came to the new school. We remember that we all had new straw hats almost like the boys have on in the picture only the mothers put ribbons on the girls' hats that were sometimes turned up in front with a ribbon bow. Going barefoot that spring term was another great thing. We think the Spring term was April, May, June and fall and winter term September through January - not sure though." Many older boys did not go to school during months that they were needed at home to do farm work.
