Katherine Thomas was born in Bracken county, Ky., April 25, 1827. At the age of 14 she united with the Methodist church. She was married to Lewis Thomas on Feb. 22, 1849. Of this union were born five children all of whom are alive and were present at her obsequies.

In 1858 Mrs. Thomas removed with her husband from Ky. to Mo. and settled upon the farm upon which she died. She died suddenly at 6 o'clock Jan. 1, 1903. The next day at 2:30 p. m. the funeral was conducted by Rev. S. E. Shafer of the M. E. church, after which the remains were laid to rest in Cedar Grove cemetery. Mrs. Thomas was a good mother, a dutiful wife, and an obliging neighbor. The family have the sympathy of the entire community in their loss.
