The Cedar & Vernon County Missouri Genealogical Society will meet **March 16 at 10 a.m. at the Bushwhacker Museum, 212 W. Walnut St, Nevada, MO.** Following a brief business meeting, “Nevada: Then and Now” will be presented by Will Tollerton, Museum director. He will show a slideshow of historic photos of Nevada landmarks alongside how the locations currently appear and provide some history of the locations.

The Society is working to determine how members without email can best be notified of upcoming meetings and business of the Society. This email as well as the previous meeting notification will be mailed to local members who do not have email at this time. If you receive a mailed copy and now have email, please notify the Society.

Until the new El Dorado Springs Library is constructed and a meeting room is available, the Genealogical Society plans to hold the April-November meetings in the Nevada Library Annex. Please always check the email notice and the website.

The Genealogy Society operates on a calendar year basis, and \$10 dues for 2022 are to be received no later than the upcoming March meeting. Following the March meeting, a final notice/email will be sent to any member who has not paid 2022 dues before a name is removed from the email and membership list. Members can always email the Society regarding their membership status.

Status of the Cemetery Directory update:

Work continues on the new Vernon County Cemetery Directory. Cemeteries remaining to be surveyed include Click, Deepwood (South rows 1-15), Heavisides, Kaufman, McKill Chapel, Toalson, and Warkins. At this time we are waiting for Warkins Cemetery to be burned off by the area landowner so it can be surveyed. It was not surveyed in preparation for the 2010 directory so special effort will be made to survey it for the new directory. When a day/time is set for surveying Warkins, an email will be sent out asking for volunteers to help. Survey data continues to be added to the database on a near-daily basis. Printing is scheduled for later this year.

Best Choice UPC for Cash: Please remember that you can bring Best Choice UPC labels to any meeting or place them in the Best Choice box in the Nevada Genealogy Department. The Society receives cash for the labels and funds are used to purchase additional Genealogical Dept resources. A big “Thank you” to Neoma F. for collecting and submitting our labels.
